KIRKER ADDS NEW REDUCER OPTIONS FOR BETTER PERFORMANCE FROM PAINTS, PRIMERS AND CLEARS

NEWBURGH, NY / JANUARY 20, 2008 – Kirker has added a new super slow option to its ULTRA-GLO Urethane-Grade Reducers, and will soon begin selling all four speeds in quart-sized packaging. At the same time, the company is also offering its three ACRYL-GLO acrylic enamel reducers in quart-sized packages.

The new super slow urethane-grade reducer, UR-9095, is intended for extremely high heat situations. Having a reducer option designed for temperatures above 90°F has become increasingly important as more refinish shops in southern markets continue switching to materials made by Kirker Automotive Finishes.

Choosing the correct speed reducer is critical in automotive refinish applications. With the addition of UR-9095, there are now four different speeds from which to choose. This new high-temperature option features super slow solvents that allow the coating film to stay wet long enough to ensure good flow and leveling, while preserving a high gloss finish.

ULTRA-GLO urethane-grade reducers are blended from 100% pure virgin solvents. They are used in the company's urethane clearcoats, 2K urethane primers, epoxy primers, single-stage urethane topcoats and SPECTRA Series urethane candy color systems.

For greater flexibility in the paint shop, Kirker is also making its ULTRA-GLO Urethane-grade and ACRYL-GLO acrylic enamel reducers available in quarts.
